



SPRING HILL FARM
CAMPSITE

Walk to Great Tew!

FOR AN ICE CREAM, COFFEE OR A PINT!

THE VILLAGE OF GREAT TEW CAN BE REACHED ON FOOT VIA FOOTPATH FROM SPRING HILL FARM. IT IS APPROX. 3.5 MILES AWAY.

Great Tew is a quaint village with a lovely cafe called Cotswold Café (also known as Quince and Clover). It is also home to the Falkland Arms - a lovely pub. Its a fairly challenging walk with some steep hills but it's worth the trek! Expect it to take you approx. 1.5 hrs each way.

1. Exit the Farm

Turn left out of Spring Hill Farm.



2. Road to Footpath

Follow the road to the T-junction (signposted Barford St Michael).



2. Join Footpath

Just past the T-junction, take the footpath gate on the left.



3. Cross Field

Follow the path straight across the field and go through the tall gate at the end.



4. Diagonal Path

Head diagonally across the field, trees on your right.



5. Wood, Bridge and Gate

Go through the gate and turn right into the wooded area along the hedge line. At the end of the hedge, cross the small wooden bridge and go through the gate.



6. Towards Hedge Gap

Head diagonally across the field towards the gap in the hedge.



7. Stone Track

Join the stone track running along the hedge on your right.



8. Climb Hill

At the end of the hedge follow the track round to the left to head up the hill (take a breath, it's quite steep!)

Follow the track and at the top follow it around to the left.

9. Reach Road

Continue straight ahead until you meet the main road. Turn left along the verge, then right down the tarmac driveway.



10. Down to Farm

Go down the steep tarmac driveway, through the gate by the cattle grid and take the left fork downhill.



11. Behind Barn

After the next gate, turn left and walk behind the barn.



Go through the gate and head towards the wooded area.



12. To Woods

Continue ahead across the field towards the wooded area.

13. Woodland Gate

Take the gate at the edge of the woods and continue ahead.



14. Track Right

Go through the next gate and follow the stone track to the right (Groveash Lane)

15. Long Track

Continue along Groveash Lane track (approx. 1 mile).



16. Join Roadway

Turn left to join the other stone roadway.

17. Into Woods

Follow the stone track into the wooded area.



18. Tarmac Road

Stay on the track as it turns to tarmac and bends sharply left uphill.

You're nearly there! Another 10 minutes and you should be at the café or the pub!



19. Approaching Village

Pass houses and a thatched cottage on your right.

20. Enter Great Tew

Continue up the final hill into the village.



The Cafe

Turn left in the village - the café is on your left in the old Post Office.

The Falkland Arms

A short walk further brings you to the pub, also on the left.



Return Options

Retrace your steps to return to Spring Hill Farm, or take an alternative route using an Ordnance Survey map or the OS Map App
